## KNOWING YOUR HORIZON CAMERA



### Lens

Avoid touching the lens itself. This will reduce or eliminate scratches and fingerprints during recording.

### Power Button

Press to turn the camera on/off.

### Micro SD Card Slot

We recommend: High endurance - class 10 or higher MLC MicroSD card 32-128GB.

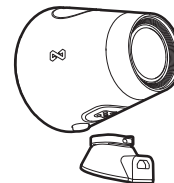

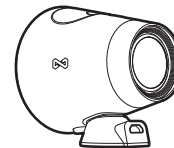
### Mount Release Button

*The Waylens camera is the high-performance piece of equipment and should be handled with care.*

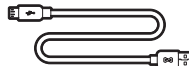
## DESKTOP CHARGING



1. Attach the USB adapter to the camera, make sure it clicks into place.



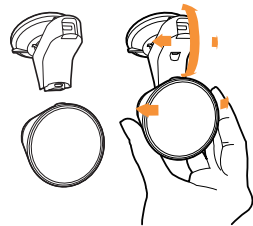
2. Once connected, plug the mini USB end of the power/data cable into the adapter and plug the standard USB connector into your computer for charging.



3. Connect the USB adapter to the camera and connect the power/data cable to charge it.

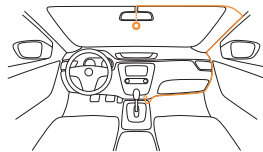
## INSTALLING THE WINDSHIELD MOUNT AND POWER CABLE



1. Once you've identified a safe and proper location for the camera, make sure the windshield is clean and residue-free.

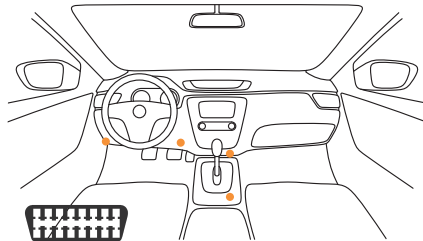
*Note: Make sure the camera does not block your view of the road.*

2. Remove the protective film from the windshield mount and adhere to the windshield.
3. Secure the camera to the mount by aligning the 5-pin contacts on the camera to the 5-pin connection on the mount and press them together.



4. Once the camera is attached to the mount properly, align the camera for the proper viewing angle and tighten the locking wheel counter-clockwise to secure.
5. Install the car charger (12v negative ground only) and route the 13' power cable to the camera mount with the provided cable clips.

## INSTALLING THE DATA MODULE (OBD II)



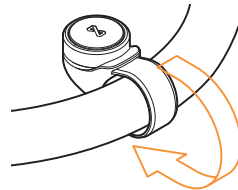
Plug the Horizon Data Module into the OBD port in your vehicle.

*Note: most vehicles 1996 and newer have this connection.*

*Can't find the OBD port?*

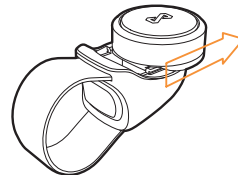
*Refer to the vehicle user manual to locate your OBD port.*

## INSTALLING THE REMOTE CONTROL (BLE)



Your system comes with a remote control to provide a safe way to highlight moments of interest.

Attach it to your steering wheel using the supplied strap and remove plastic tab.



You may also remove it from the strap and affix it to any clean surface using the supplied double-sided tape.

# STANDARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Waylens, Inc. ("Waylens") delivers Waylens cameras, mounts, cables, kits, or modules, including any accompanying software, components, documentation (collectively, "Products") to users in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth herein ("Terms"). Acceptance of the Products is expressly subject to these Terms. Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, if a written contract signed by both parties is in existence covering the sale of the Products, the terms and conditions of said contract shall prevail to the extent they are inconsistent with these Terms.

## 1. ACCEPTANCE OF TERMS:

You acknowledge and agree that by accessing or using the products, you, your heirs, and assigns (collectively, "you" or "your") are indicating that you have read, understand and agree to be bound by these terms. If you do not agree to these terms, then you have no right to access or right to use the products and should return them immediately.

## 2. SYSTEM SOFTWARE LICENSE:

The software embedded in the camera, remote and other devices ("system software") is licensed for use on such devices only in accordance with the following license terms.

- 2.1 Conditioned upon Your compliance with these Terms, Waylens hereby grants to You a limited, non-exclusive and nontransferable license to use the System Software for personal use on a single Product owned or otherwise controlled by You. Waylens reserves all rights in the System Software not expressly granted to You in these Terms.
- 2.2 Except as expressly and unambiguously permitted by these Terms, You shall not: (i) copy (except in the course of loading or installing) or modify the System Software, including but not limited to, adding new features or otherwise making adaptations that alter the functioning of the System Software; (ii) transfer, sublicense, rent, lease, lend or otherwise distribute the System Software to any third party; (c) make the functionality of the System Software available to multiple users through any means, including, but not limited to, by uploading the System Software to a network or file-sharing service or through any hosting, application service provider, service bureau, software-as-a-service or any other type of services.
- 2.3 Your copy of the System Software is licensed, not sold. Waylens retains ownership of the copyright, title and ownership of the System Software and any accompanying written materials, including all intellectual property rights therein, regardless of the form or media in or on which the original and other copies may exist. The System Software is protected by United State copyright law and international treaties. - 3.2 Except for the limited right to use the products set forth herein, nothing in these terms and conditions shall be construed as granting or conferring any rights by license, patent, or any other industrial or intellectual property right of waylens, its suppliers/licensors or any other third party, to use the products in any finished end-user or ready-to-use other product, or for any invention, discovery or improvement made, conceived or acquired prior to or after delivery of the products.

## 4. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY:

- 4.1 In no event shall waylens or its vendors be liable for: (i) special, indirect, incidental, or consequential damages even if known to waylens or vendor; (ii) damages resulting from loss of data, use, or profits; (iii) damages resulting from use of the products while driving; (iv) any other damages resulting from your use or possession of the products; or (v) any claim, whether in contract or tort, that arose more than one year prior to the institution of suit thereon. Waylens uses Your location and route information to create a detailed location history of all of Your journeys made when using the Products. Waylens uses this history to offer the Products to You, to improve the quality of the Products it offers to You and to all of its users and to improve the accuracy of its mapping and navigation data. This history is retained by Waylens for a limited period of time and in accordance with the Privacy Policy.

## 9. MISCELLANEOUS:

- 9.1 These terms and conditions shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, without reference to conflict-of-laws principles. You agree that exclusive jurisdiction for any dispute arising out of or relating to these terms and conditions lies within courts located in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and consent to venue in Suffolk County, Massachusetts.
